

Benefits of Actions to Reduce Household Air Pollution (BAR HAP) Tool

TERMS OF USE

Please read these Terms of Use (the "**Agreement**") before using the Benefits of Actions to Reduce Household Air Pollution (BAR-HAP) Tool (the "**Tool**").

By using the Tool, you enter into an agreement with the World Health Organization ("WHO") and you accept all terms, conditions, and requirements of the Agreement.

1. Components of the Tool

The Tool was developed by WHO. The Tool calculates the benefits and costs of household energy transition(s) from use of certain fuels and technologies (e.g., use of biomass in a traditional stove) to cleaner options (e.g., biomass stove with fan and chimney, LPG stove, electric stove).

To use the Tool, users must select "household energy transition(s)" and "policy intervention(s)". The Tool includes default selections, and default values for all input data, which can be modified by the user. The Tool incorporates the WHO NCD Costing Tool framework (World Health Organization. Prevention and Control of Noncommunicable Diseases: Guidelines for Primary Health Care in Low Resource Settings. Simplified tools for implementation of the guidelines. 2012. The Tool uses information on health impacts of exposure to air pollution (the "**Data**") to produce output information on the relative risk of exposure. The Tool is a downloadable Microsoft Excel file, which contains the Data and also allows the user to upload their own data into the Tool.

This Agreement governs your use of the Tool accessible through the Microsoft Excel file, including use of the Data.

You are responsible for any data or content uploaded to the Tool and retain full ownership of it.

2. Third-party Software

- 2.1. Third-party software used to build the Tool. The Tool must be downloaded from a web browser and opened in Microsoft Excel.
- 2.2. WHO disclaimers for third-party software. WHO makes no warranties whatsoever, and specifically disclaims any and all warranties, express or implied, that either the Microsoft Excel software or any web browser used to access the Tool are free of defects, virus free, able to operate on an uninterrupted basis, merchantable, fit for a particular purpose, accurate, non-infringing or appropriate for your technical system.
