- Working households are making trade-off's between Non-COVID economic impacts and COVID impacts. We need to understand them and take them seriously.
- Our frameworks must enable them to choose healthy behaviour, not think only in terms of compliance and information
- Enabling here means returning to the social determinants the pandemic cannot be overcome without social protection.
- The message for social protection must come as much from public health
 + medicine + science as it does from economists, workers, and activists
