## Workshops:

### **Healthcare without Harm**

Workshop Title: Climate-Smart Healthcare: Leadership and pathways to environmentally sustainable healthcare in South-East Asia

As the Climate crisis steadily escalates, a global agenda for action calls for all sectors to take responsible action to adapt and become environmentally sustainable. The health sector too has a critical role. As "first responders", health professionals must be equipped to adapt, become resilient and prepare to handle the additional disease burden due to climate change. Paradoxically, the health sector also has a role in greenhouse gas emissions and must recognise and reduce or mitigate its own carbon footprint. Health Care Without Harm (HCWH) is an international nongovernmental organization (NGO) that works to transform health care worldwide so that it reduces its environmental footprint, becomes a community anchor for sustainability, and a leader in the global movement for environmental health and justice. This workshop will showcase exemplars of leadership, national policy, roadmaps for action and opportunities for collaborative partnerships for action that can be emulated and leveraged, to help move the needle in the SEARO region for transformative action towards environmentally sustainable healthcare.

Workshop Title: Health Students as Leaders and Advocates

The role of future health professionals is imperative to drive the mobilization of the health community for climate action.
