



Since October 2023, four new projects were initiated in Haiti, Nepal, occupied Palestinian territory and the Syrian Arab Republic. Across all active projects, a thorough baseline, including information on the availability of essential health services, has been established for close to 60 000 HSDUs. Furthermore, the continuous monitoring approach has resulted in the submission of **over 100 000 new HSDU updates** over the last 12 months.

In the last 12 months, the HeRAMS platform has seen continuous growth, with over 1700 new users joining. This represents a notable 14% increase in the total user community, bringing the cumulative number of registered users to close to 13900.

#### **CAPACITY BUILDING**




43 Training events



1352 Participants trained

Over the last 12 months, 43 training events were conducted accross 11 countries, reaching close to 1400 participants. Through a mix of on-site, online, and hybrid formats, key informants and project administrators were trained in the HeRAMS methodology, equipping them to contribute and use data effectively.
