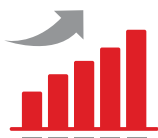

Ear and hearing care interventions are cost-effective



US\$ 1.60



An annual additional investment of less than US\$ 1.60 per person is needed to provide ear and hearing care services

EXPANDING ACCESS TO EAR & HEARING CARE SERVICES REQUIRES INVESTMENT



Over a 10-year period, this promises a return of nearly US\$ 17 for every US dollar invested
