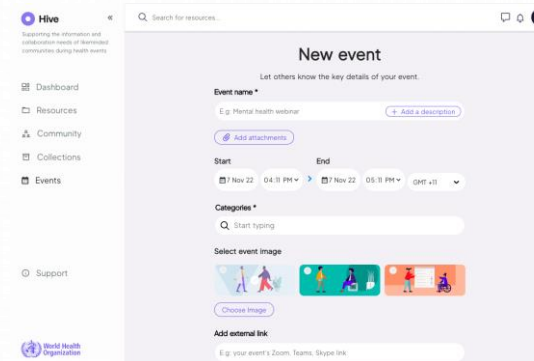


Features of Hive



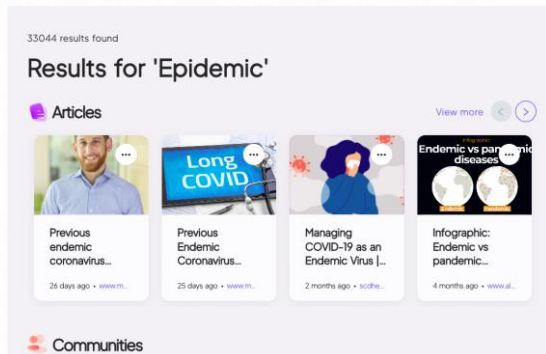
Community collaboration tools

- Community conversation/posting based on specific topic



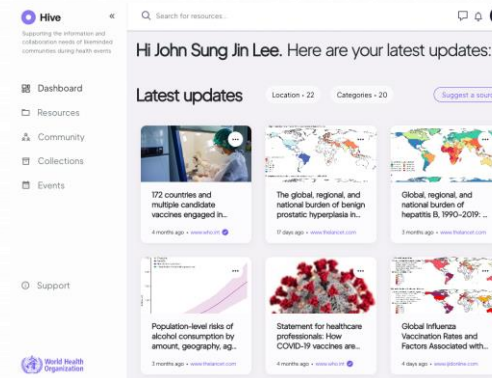
