Laboratory Management Series Part Two - Process Management

Highlights and Key Messages

In this session we talked about the importance of mapping and understanding laboratory processes in order to be able to identify errors, apply corrective actions and streamline these processes in order to optimize laboratory workflow. We introduced process maps and flowcharts which are helpful in visualizing activities to analyse the steps and identify any inefficiencies. We listened to Dr Hamid Irshad's experience identifying a potential error in study results and the steps his laboratory took to identify and correct the error. We used the 5-why analysis tool to understand more deeply root-causes

Key Points:

- Process management involves planning and administering the activities necessary to achieve a high level of performance
- · Process mapping and flow charts are useful tools for examining the process and identifying areas for improvement
- Root-cause-analysis can help to identify the source of errors and allow for preventative and corrective actions




