

PRET National Pandemic Preparedness Plans are Updated

Approach

• Engage with countries – Emergency preparedness, DPC, ID focal point

 Identify relevant national documents: NAPHS, Previous IPPP, All Hazards Plan, JEE, COVID-19 Response plan etc.

- Host regional multi-country workshops;
- Country teams mentored to update/develop plan using current plans, tools etc.
- Outcome: draft 0 of Respiratory Pathogen Pandemic Preparedness Plan

- Countries supported to finalise plan;
- Multisectoral stakeholder workshops;
- Simulation exercise.




