Project objective: Improving understanding and awareness of Codex Alimentarius standards with a view to boosting compliance and increasing the competitiveness of food items marketed locally, regionally and internationally.

- Output 1 – National Codex Alimentarius awareness programme
 - Activity 1.1 – Developing communication materials
 - Activity 1.2 – Conducting a national awareness campaign on the roles and responsibilities of stakeholders regarding the importance the work of Codex
- Output 2 – Strengthening the governance and management system of the National Codex Alimentarius Committee (NCAC)
 - Activity 2.1 – Monitoring the adoption and dissemination of the draft decree on the reorganization and operation of the NCAC.
 - Activity 2.2 – Developing documentation relating to the management of Codex (rules of procedure, organization and operation of the committees, consultation mechanism, designation of national officials attending Codex meetings, dissemination of information, etc.).
- Output 3 –NCAC stakeholder capacity building
 - Activity 3.1 – Training Codex Members and the secretariat on the Commission's procedural guidelines and the FAO/WHO Codex training package
 - Activity 3.2 – Enhancing the capacities of NCAC scientific expert groups and laboratories to effectively participate in and contribute to the work of priority committees and FAO/WHO joint expert bodies
 - Activity 3.3 – Supporting participation in the work of the Codex Commission and its subsidiary bodies (participation of 2 delegates in meetings of CAC, CC-AFRICA, CCFH, CCCF, CCPR)
 - Activity 3.4 – Evaluating the work of priority committees
- Output 4 – Support for updating national regulations, in accordance with the SBS and TBT Agreements.
 - Activity 4.1 – Contributing to the development and wider dissemination of standards in the local fisheries, peanuts processing and cereals sectors
 - Activity 4.2 – Facilitating compliance with Codex standards by professionals in the fisheries, peanut processing and local cereals sectors
