## REGIONAL WORKSHOP ON TB SURVEILLANCE AND IMPACT MONITORING IN AFRICA

#### Harare, Zimbabwe- 29 November to 3 December 2010

#### **Objectives**

- (1) to discuss the major recommendations for measuring TB incidence, prevalence and mortality provided by the WHO Global Task Force on TB Impact Measurement;
- (2) to review existing estimates of TB incidence, prevalence and mortality and the methods used to produce them, on a country-by-country basis; and
- (3) to assess the reliability and completeness of notification data, what percentage of incident TB cases are included in TB notifications, and whether trends in TB notifications reflect trends in TB incidence.
- (4) to make concrete suggestions on how to improve TB control impact measurements and accuracy of data in order to influence future prioritization of strategies.

#### **Expected Outcomes**

- 1. All participants understand current TB disease burden estimation methods, how they have been applied for their own country and have identified how the estimates could be improved with available data or with data that could be compiled in the future
- 2. Agreement on updated TB estimates
- 3. Definition of next steps to improve estimates

#### **Methods**

- 1. Review/discuss existing methods (incidence, prevalence and mortality).
- 2. Application of WHO framework for assessment of incidence.
- 3. Presentations, plenary discussion and group work. The group work will consist of a set of questions for each country to answer. The facilitator will explain each question with examples of possible answers. Each country will then answer the question on their own
