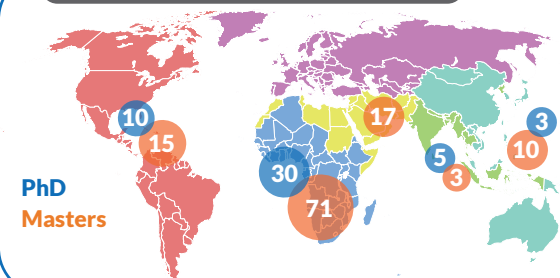

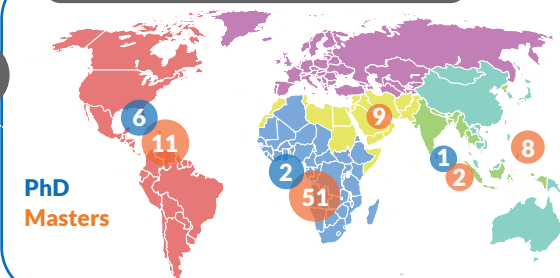

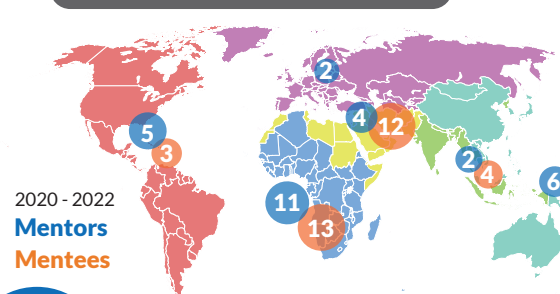
CUMULATIVE ENROLLMENT
