

## Mandate for ASEAN Science and Technology Cooperation (ASEAN Declaration of 8 August 1967)

 ASEAN shall promote active collaboration and mutual assistance on matters of common interest in the economic, social, cultural, technical, scientific and administrative fields and provide assistance to each other in the form of training and research facilities in the educational, professional, technical and administrative spheres.



## **Priority Areas of Cooperation in Health Sector**

• The ASEAN Health Sector cooperates with other external partners to achieve a healthy and caring ASEAN Community, wherein the people achieve maximal health potential through the promotion of healthy lifestyles; responding to all hazards and emerging threats; strengthening health systems and access to care; and, ensuring food safety in the region.
