The Hospital Solution Hubs is a bold new undertaking, pioneered by the World Health Organization (WHO) supporting hospitals and their frontline workers, to create locally owned solutions to some of the most pressing care delivery challenges faced. The Hubs complement WHO's support for hospital reforms, national strategy development, and capacity building for hospital and emergency unit management.

WHAT IS A HOSPITAL SOLUTION HUB?

Hospital Solution Hubs will be established in different countries and each hub will be comprised of the WHO country office, a local partner organization, and a hospital, and receive technical support from WHO and the WHO Regional Office.

The Hubs will empower and capacitate multi-disciplinary hospital teams with the best-practice skills in innovation and design while facilitating them through a process to turn their ideas into implementable and scalable solutions. Country hubs will become part of a global network of hubs, receiving opportunities for cross-country learning and sharing.
