




# **MAKE YOUR INJECTION** A SAFE INJECTION

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

An unsafe injection could put you at risk of getting a life-threatening infection such as:







Estimated risk of getting these infections from a contaminated syringe or needle.

## **WHAT MAKES AN INJECTION UNSAFE?**

Re-use of syringes and needles, and other injection equipment.

**Overuse of injections** for illnesses where medicines by mouth are available and recommended.

Lack of clean work spaces and hands.

**Unsafe collection** and disposal of used injection equipment.

**PATIENTS** who receive unsafe injections.



#### CHILDREN IN THE **COMMMUNITY**

who play near areas where syringes and needles have been thrown away.



**HEALTH CARE WORKERS** who get injured

by used needles.
