WHO global survey on the minimum requirements for infection prevention and control at the national and facility levels

Introduction to the WHO global survey on Minimum Requirements for IPC

The WHO core components recommendations have become the reference for building effective IPC programmes. Countries are meant to include them in their AMR national action plans and use them to support the implementation of the International Health Regulations. Subsequently, WHO launched the Minimum requirements (MR) for infection prevention and control programmes at the national and health care facility level and has provided tools to support their implementation, the WHO assessment tools on IPC minimum requirements for secondary and tertiary health care facilities being the lasted ones and launched at the start of this survey.

The WHO IPC Hub Unit at WHO headquarters is organizing a special series of webinars to introduce and train for the WHO global survey on MR for IPC. In the first session, team members from the WHO IPC Hub Unit will introduce and discuss key elements of the survey.
