Carlos Cezar Flores Vidotti is a certified pharmacist and holds a doctoral degree in Health Sciences.

He worked in the Federal Council of Pharmacy building up and developing the Brazilian Drug Information Centre (CEBRIM/CFF, for 18 years, and helping development of Drug Information Centres and its network in Brazil.

Since 2001, he is member of the Committee for Brazilian Nonproprietary Names for Pharmaceutical Substances (DCB), within the Brazilian Pharmacopoeia, linked to the Brazilian Health Surveillance Agency (ANVISA). In 2012, he became DCB Committee's Coordinator.

He is civil public servant at Brazilian Ministry of Health. He is also professor of pharmacoepidemiology/pharmacovigilance in a Pharmacy School. He is full member of the Brazilian Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences.
