Prescrire provides to Medical Doctors and Pharmacists reliable, rigorously independent information on treatment and healthcare strategies, to enable fully informed decision-making. Prescrire is financed only by its subscribers and Gilles Mignot has no conflicts of interest, in particular with Pharmaceutical Industry for more than 25 years.

He had various missions of public interest: Expert for Belgian national consensus conference; joint rapporteur of the INAMI report commissioned by the Belgian Ministry of Health on good antidepressant usage; Member of the WHO Expert Committee for the 14th WHO list of essential drugs; Contributor to the 14th edition of Dukes MNG and al Meyler's side effects of Drugs; Member of the French Observatory of Drug Prescriptions; etc

He regularly makes educational missions on rational drug use, independent information on medicinal products, analysis of assessment files for new drugs, etc for Prescrire and ISDB (International Society of Drug Bulletins): France, Tunisia, Morocco, Algeria and Italy.
