Biography

Vicent Rodilla is currently professor of Toxicology at University CEU Cardenal Herrera, Valencia, Spain. He teaches Medicine, Pharmacy and Veterinary students and he also lectures in several postgraduate courses. He has received funding and has carried out several projects on teaching innovation.

Vincent Rodilla graduated in Biological Sciences at University of Valencia and received a PhD in the Genetics program from the same University. His PhD research work, however, was carried out at the Radiobiology Research Group, St. Luke's Hospital, and at the Dublin Institute of Technology, both in Dublin, Ireland. He also worked as Scientific Officer at the Nuclear Energy Board of Ireland, and at the University of Aberdeen, Scotland, where he obtained a Fellowship in Toxicology from the Wellcome Trust. He then became a Lecturer at the Robert Gordon University also in Aberdeen.

He has ample research experience and has received funding from National Agencies and Industry. He is a reviewer for several scientific journals in toxicology, veterinary research, and pharmaceuticals and for national funding agencies in project evaluation. He has supervised MSc and PhD studies on renal metal toxicity, drug biotransformation, metallothionein, drug prescription, patient compliance, pharmacoeconomics as well as analytical studies and techniques. His latest research is on 3D printing for drug delivery and on novel strategies for the treatment of ocular disorders.
