## *Biography*

Sarel Malan (B.Pharm, M.Sc., DTE, Ph.D.) is Professor and Director of the School of Pharmacy, University of the Western Cape and Extraordinary Professor in Pharmaceutical Chemistry at North-West University where he was previously employed as Professor. He is a Fellow and current President of the Pharmaceutical Society of South Africa and a National Research Foundation (NRF) C1 rated scientist.

He has served in various capacities on executive committees of the Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences and Pharmaceutical Society of SA; is a member of expert committees of the South African Medicines Control Council (MCC) and WHO, Advisory panels of the Soluth African National Research Foundation (NRF), Standards Generating Body for Pharmacy and South African Pharmacy Council Inspection Panels.

In his academic career he has supervised or co-supervised 60 M.Sc. and 12 Ph.D. studies in Pharmaceutical/Medicinal Chemistry and Pharmaceutics; published 62 peer reviewed articles in subsidised international journals, 1 book chapter, 5 papers in professional journals, 4 conference proceedings and 2 research reports, and has various national and international conference contributions; acted as external examiner and moderator for undergraduate courses, M.Sc. dissertations and Ph.D. theses for Singapore University, NMMU (UPE), University of KwaZula-Natal, University of the Western Cape, South African Pharmacy Council, Rhodes University, North-West University, University of Pretoria, University of the Witwatersrand and National University of Lesotho. He is an Editorial Board Member of The Open Medicinal Chemistry Journal (TOMCJ) and Open Medicinal Chemistry Letters (OMCL), Bentham Scientific Publishers; Reviewer/Evaluator

for National Research Foundation (Rating, funding and Innovation fund), MRC South Africa and various Scientific Journals (South African Journal of Science, Organic Letters, Life Sciences, Letters in Organic Chemistry, Metabolic Brain Disease, Biorganic and Medicinal Chemistry, European Journal of Medicinal Chemistry and European Journal of Pharmacology amongst others).
