## **Biography**

Dr Tony Manderson is currently the Head of the Cell & Tissue Therapy Unit at the Therapeutic Goods Administration in Australia. The Unit is responsible for policy and evaluation of human cell and tissue-based products (known as biologicals), including gene-modified cell therapies. He first joined the TGA in 2007 and has worked in different areas, including the evaluation and testing of vaccines, regulation of blood and plasma-derived medicines, and most recently the regulation of blood, HPCs and human cell and tissue-based therapies (biologicals). Prior to this, Dr. Manderson worked as a research scientist at Imperial College in London and the Institute of Molecular Biosciences in Brisbane, with a focus on complement biology, autoimmunity and macrophage biology, after obtaining his PhD in Immunology from the Australian National University in Canberra, Australia.
