Evaluation of declarations of interest

Two virtual technical consultations were convened by WHO in 2025 to guide the development of the Compendium of Molecular Markers for Antimalarial Drug Resistance. These consultations provided expert input on the methodology for evidence review and marker classification, and participants also contributed to the review and validation of the classification of molecular markers.

All independent experts invited to participate submitted Declarations of Interest (DOIs) in advance of each session. Fifteen experts submitted their DOIs in March 2025 for Session 1, held on 27 March 2025. These declarations were reviewed by the WHO Secretariat. Two experts submitted updated declarations for Session 2, held on 16 July 2025, which were likewise reviewed by the Secretariat.

All declarations were assessed by Dr Andrea Bosman, Unit Head, GMP/DMR, and Ms Charlotte Rasmussen, Technical Officer, GMP/DMR. Of the eighteen independent experts participating in these consultations, seven reported no interests and eight reported interests. The reported interests were reviewed and determined to be not relevant to the subject matter or outcomes of the technical consultation. Therefore, all experts were considered fully eligible to participate in the discussions and deliberations.
