

# 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) Emergency Readiness/ Response

Country: MALDIVES Date: 24 / 03 / 2021

### **Cases reporting**

- 22,662 confirmed cases have been reported till date.
- 1090 new cases have been reported since last week, and there are 2,447 active cases in the country currently more than 1,856 active cases are in the greater Male' region.
- **02 additional deaths** were reported during the week and mortality rate 0.29% with **66 deaths**.
- 612,223 samples have been tested till date. **Sample positivity rate** is at **3%**. Cases continue to be seen more among **contacts** of positives and from departure samples from tourists and travelers.
- **1049 new recoveries** were reported during the week. 20,142 (89%) have recovered. **107** people are **hospitalized** with moderate to severe disease, no cases in ICU or on ventilator care.
- There are currently **196** active cases across **43 islands outside Male**.
- Kudahuvadhoo island in **Dhaalu atoll** has been placed under monitoring following the confirmation of 22
  active cases in the community. The island was placed under monitoring for contact tracing and case
  investigation, after six samples collected from individual working at Kudahuvadhoo Airport, returned
  positive for the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.
- The clusters from Seenu Atoll and Gnaviyani Atoll Fuvah Mulak currently report no active cases.
- In tourist establishments and operational resorts, a total of **442 cases** have been reported from **97 resorts** across the country. 51% of cases seen among tourists this week.

## **Developments/ activities carried out by Member State**

- Over 220,768 persons have been vaccinated with COVISHIELD. 97,541 were from atolls COVID-19.
- The tourism ministry said special efforts are undertaken to vaccinate tourism employees, over 12,793 tourism employees have received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. This includes 12,048 resort staff, 306 guesthouse staff, 214 staff of liveaboards and 70 hotel staff.
- Sinopharm vaccination for people of 18 and 60 years of age started on 22 March, 2021. Over 1,500 people have received the vaccine on day 1.
- Health Protection Agency (HPA) announced that a new amendment was brought to their guidelines on public health and social measures for cafes' and restaurants, allowing them to remain open until 2230hrs.
- Guidelines are in preparation for social measures to be implemented during Ramadan, including prayers in mosques with social distancing measures in consultation with Ministry of Islamic Affairs.
- Over 20,000 individuals affected by the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic have received the income support.

#### **WCO** activities

- WHO continues to monitor the vaccination sites and is actively involved in deliberations of the National Vaccine Steering Group and Operations Group.
- Supporting the launching of TB screening in Himmafushi Island Prison, and the activities for World TB Day 2021.
- Continuing technical support to Ministry of Health for producing National Health Accounts (2018-2020);
- Supporting IPC Measures: such as ongoing efforts to monitor the vaccination sites for IPC related support.
- Support in organizing stakeholder meetings to finalize the National IPC guidelines.



## **WHO support provided to Member State**

- Providing guidance to HEOC/HPA and TAG on WHO recommendations with the latest updates from IHR Committee meetings.
- WCO handed over 100,000 enzyme kits which are required to conduct COVID-19 diagnosis with RT PCR test kits.
- WHO handed over IT equipment to plan Revitalizing Primary Health Care in the country
