#### 2. World Patient Safety Day 2022

#### 17 September 2022

World Patient Safety Day is one of <u>WHO's global public health days</u>. It was established in 2019 by the Seventy-second World Health Assembly through the adoption of resolution <u>WHA72.6 – "Global action on patient safety"</u>. Its objectives are to increase public awareness and engagement, enhance global understanding, and work towards global solidarity and action by Member States to enhance patient safety and reduce patient harm.

#### Objectives of World Patient Safety Day 2022:

- 1. RAISE global awareness of the high burden of medication-related harm due to medication errors and unsafe practices, and ADVOCATE urgent action to improve medication safety.
- 2. ENGAGE key stakeholders and partners in the efforts to prevent medication errors and reduce medication-related harm.
- 3. EMPOWER patients and families to be actively involved in the safe use of medication.
- 4. SCALE UP implementation of the WHO Global Patient Safety Challenge: *Medication Without Harm*.
