

WHO Campaign on Medical Devices



The "2023 Call for **Innovative Health Technologies for Low-Resource Settings" is** open now and it focuses on NCDs.

Each year, 17 million people die from noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) before age 70; 86% of these premature deaths occur in low- and middleincome countries.

Low-resource settings often struggle to identify health technologies tailored to their needs. However, innovative technologies could offer a solution to their unmet needs.

WHO is pleased to announce the opening of the 2023 Call for innovative health technologies for low-resource settings. If you or your team have developed an innovative health technology submit it today! The call is open for prototypes, commercially available technologies, and updates from the previous versions of the WHO Compendium.

Despite the focus on NCDs, this call also considers submissions of technologies related to other diseases and health conditions.
