## Global School-based Student Health Survey Madagascar 2025 Fact Sheet



The 2025 Madagascar GSHS was a school-based survey of students in T7 - Terminale (typically attended by students aged 13 – 17 years). A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in T7 - Terminale in Madagascar. At the first stage, 38 schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate.

The Madagascar GSHS measured alcohol use, dietary behaviours, drug use, hygiene, mental health, physical activity, protective factors, sexual behaviours, tobacco use, and violence and unintentional injury. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer scannable answer sheet.

The school response rate was 100%, the student response rate was 87.2%, and the overall response rate was 87.2%. A total of 2440 students participated in the Madagascar GSHS. Weighted prevalence estimates (percentages) and 95% confidence intervals are presented below.
