## Global School-based Student Health Survey Philippines 2024 Fact Sheet



The 2024 Philippines GSHS was a school-based survey of students in Grade 7 - Grade 10 (typically attended by students aged 13 – 17 years). A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in Grade 7 - Grade 10 in Philippines. At the first stage, 96 schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate.

The Philippines GSHS measured Alcohol Use; Dietary Behaviours; Drug Use; Hygiene; Mental Health; Physical Activity; Protective Factors; Sexual Behaviours; & Violence and Unintentional Injury. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer scannable answer sheet.

The school response rate was 97.9%, the student response rate was 80.1%, and the overall response rate was 78.5%. A total of 8618 students participated in the Philippines GSHS. Weighted prevalence estimates (percentages) and 95% confidence intervals are presented below.
