

- Urgently prioritise ready access to sufficient quantity of high-quality and appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) for nurses and other healthcare workers
- Ensure the financial protection and compensation of nurses

Demonstrate public support and recognise the value of nurses to society

- Ensure all nurses have appropriate evidence-based infection prevention and control training and the latest COVID-19-specific guidance and training
- Provide a safe and effective
 Registration and Regulatory
 response when rapidly expanding
 the nursing workforce
- Capitalise on nursing leadership

- Protect the health and wellbeing of nurses and other healthcare workers
- Ensure a safe and effective deployment of nursing staff to areas of high demand and high complexity as the need arises
- Develop and implement a comprehensive, coordinated COVID-19 public health strategy with active engagement of nurses

- Rapidly implement/scale-up comprehensive surveillance systems to track and investigate healthcare worker infection
- Encourage, develop and support new models of care and innovation





—The number of hcw infections in 30 countries


—The estimated global number of how infections




ICN's analysis

- HCW infection rates vary significant ranging from 1% to 30%.
- On average 7% of all COVID-19 cases are among HCWs.
- Globally there could be in excess of 500,000 HCWs infections.
- Nurses are commonly the occupational group with the highest number of infections.

The General Nursing Council, or CGE has filed a complaint with the Supreme Court against the Spanish Prime Minister, Pedro Sánchez, and the Health Minister, Salvador Illa, for a crime against the safety of workers in critical health due to coronavirus.

he CGE said in a statement on Thursday that the complaint is in addition to other, different criminal proceedings filed by several Autonomous Councils and Provincial Schools of Nursing throughout Spain against the management of the different provincial and Autonomous Health Authorities.

Their judicial action originated from an agreement adopted weeks ago by the Executive Commission of the General Council of Nursing, because of the lack of safety equipment for Healthcare Professionals which resulted in wave of infections and deaths

With 500,000 estimated HCW infections, the number of HCW deaths will be in the 000's. Higher incidence amongst BAME staff.

As of 3 June 2020, at least 600 nurses have died
