- Regulations and standards for prevention of occupational hazards in the health sector.
- Objectives, targets and key indicators for monitoring and evaluation of programme implementation.



FINANCING

 Established mechanisms for efficient financing of measures for the health and safety of health workers.



HUMAN AND PHYSICAL RESOURCES

- · Adequate human resources for occupational health and safety for health workers.
- Adequate supplies and commodities readily available at all levels of the health system.



SERVICE DELIVERY

- Standards for the provision of occupational health services for health workers with a system for quality assurance and a programme for their expansion.
- Policies for the provision of support services for health workers addressing HIV, TB, and hepatitis B and C.
