

Sudan's commitment towards medication without harm

The third Global Patient Safety Challenge.

The pledge signing by H.E Sudan Minister of health in the regional launch in Muscat, Oman, 2017. The Directorate of Patient Safety / DG of Quality Sudan FMOH started a process of establishing a national medication safety program.



Why Medication Safety? What was the starting point?

2008: Afro EMRO Adverse Event Study (Wilson, 2012)

- 8.2% AE rate
- 34% Therapeutic errors

EMRO Medication Safety Standards

2014: Piloting of EMROs Medication Safety Standards in two hospitals (EMRO Report, 2014)

 More than 50% of required standards are not met

2016: Sudan Accreditation Standards for Hospitals was piloted in 8 Hospitals (FMOH, 2016)

Most of the PS and medication safety standards were not met.


Extensive LR was done Conclusion:

- Most of the hospitals in Khartoum State when assessed in terms of the basic medication safety practices did not implement them.
- Providers lack basic knowledge about ADRs.
- Facilities lack polices for ADRs.
- Compliance to standard Medication prescriptions and administration practices is low
- Most patients seeking medical care lack knowledge about their treatment.

Steps

- As an initial step, a leading body
 [National Medication Safety
 Committee] was formulated by
 engaging all related stakeholders from
 all relevant institutions
 (National/International) and experts.
- The main aim is to develop a National Medication Safety Program for healthcare facilities and implement the Medication Safety Policy Guide developed in 2017.



Methodology

The committee have been meeting on a regular basis since May 2018 with a total of five meetings so far. In these series of meetings; the committee reviewed the current Situation of Medication Management and Use in healthcare facilities.


Subsequently, a detailed process map that outlined the main issues compromising medication safety was developed.

Accordingly; related taskforces were assembled to prioritize areas of action and develop a detailed action plan.

- 6. Patient Education And Empowerment






A Set of Interventions at all levels



The main Problems was Prioritized



Sudan National Action Plan for Medication Safety


In January 2020


