Dr Mahbubur Rahman is currently working as an Assistant Professor of Department of Community Medicine and Public Health at Sher-E-Bangla Medical College, Barishal under Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Bangladesh. Before joining here in March 2025, he worked with the Institute of Epidemiology, Disease Control and Research (IEDCR), which is the National Influenza Center (NIC). He has more than 25 years of extensive working experience in the field of Epidemiology and public health. He is the course

coordinator for the Field Epidemiology Training Program, Bangladesh (FETP,B) with three tiers of courses (advanced, intermediate and frontline). He served as the Program Manager of WHO Emergency core Services programs in Bangladesh. His PhD research focus was on avian influenza risk to humans, and he is responsible for coordinating epidemiological aspect of different surveillance platforms of Bangladesh, including influenza. He voluntarily serves as the General Secretary of National Coordination Committee of One Health Bangladesh and Joint Secretary of Epidemiological Association of Bangladesh.
