

**PERUVIAN NATIONAL REPORT

I. RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

The main research activities conducted on the period 2007-2008 have been:

- Project: "Latin-American Scientific Review on High Frequency Electromagnetic Fields". This is multinational project that is aimed to provide a situational status of Latin- American countries research, regulation and social concern on Non Ionizing Radiation applications that involves Argentina, Brasil and Peru

In the "1st Latin American Symposium on high frequency Electromagnetic Fields and Human Health" that was held in Sao Paulo Brasil, May 28- 31, 2008 was presented the work developed by every country. It's expected the first stage be finished by August 2008

Peru has developed the Engineering and Standards Review and have presented a compendium of International and national regulations on high frequency electromagnetic fields used or set up in Latin- American countries. Besides that it is presented the engineering researchs developed in Latin – American and their results such as surveys, measurements and so on.

This effort is advised by Dr Mike Repacholi (La Sapienza University, Rome), Dr. Paolo Veccia (ICNIRP) and Dr Leeka Keifets (University of California –Los Angeles)
