

- B) Focus on the three dimensions of evidence use: motivation, capability, and opportunity (integral plan).






Office Utilization Level

21 reports on 14 topics Types of uses

- **01.** Understanding an issue.
- **02.** Decision-making:
 - Basis or proposals of a bill.
 - Not presenting a bill that had already been prepared.

Contributions

- **01.** Providing explanatory evidence (40%).
- **02.** Reducing workload.
- **03.** Fact-checking.
- **04.** Translating into plain language.

96 advisers enrolled in the EIP course

Challenges

Cultural

- 1. Diversity of knowledge and capabilities.
- 2. Risk of mistrust in the usefulness of evidence.

Political

- 1. Risk of offering irrelevant products.
- 2. Risk of mistrust in the Office's impartiality, confidentiality, and professional quality.

Scientific

- 1. Risk of using incomplete or low-quality evidence.
- 2. Risk of achieving low-quality products.
- 3. Risk of bias in the search and analysis.

Operative

- 1. Risk of being unknown.
- 2. Risk of offering products untimely.
- 3. Problems accessing EIP Office services.
- 4. Problems with access to evidence.
- 5. Risk of saturation of the Office.
- 6. Risk of failure to reach goals.
