Affiliation form for Together for Science & Health

Affiliation with Together for Science & Health is completed through a structured four-step process designed to ensure clarity, accountability, and alignment with the values of the global movement. This process includes:

1. Signing the declaration to confirm the entity's commitment and providing the necessary information for registration via the Together for Science & Health website.
2. Submitting core organizational details, including the entity's name, address, and other essential information required for formal registration.
3. Confirming adherence to WHO policies on engagement with non-State actors, including a declaration that the entity is neither part of nor supports the interests of the tobacco or arms industries.
4. Outlining the entity's intended contributions to the global movement, organized by collaboration area, with an opportunity to specify proposed activities and areas of engagement.

 - i. Indicate your affiliation with and participation in the Together for Science & Health movement on dedicated pages of institutional websites, technical and scientific publications, and communication materials that are specifically and directly related to Together for Science & Health activities (see below)
 - ii. Support communication, outreach and social media activities that directly promote the objectives and areas of work of the Together for Science & Health movement (see below)

WHO reserves the right, at its absolute discretion, to terminate the affiliation of any entity that has registered with WHO to be part of Together for Science & Health. WHO will notify the entity of such termination decision. In the event that WHO terminates the affiliation of any entity, such entity shall immediately cease to use the logo.
