2.1 Draft principles and guidelines for the Coordinating Subcommittee under the Royal Thai Government – World Health Organization Country Cooperation Strategy to monitor, oversee and support the implementation of all programs, ensuring clear direction in technical areas and funding management to meet the objectives of the Royal Thai Government – World Health Organization Country Cooperation Strategy (RTG-WHO CCS) 2565 – 2569 B.E.

2.2 Serve as a forum for exchanging key stakeholders' experiences, as well as a mechanism for monitoring the progress under the Royal Thai Government – World Health Organization Country Cooperation Strategy, while applying a creative/participatory approach.

2.3 Develop a framework for monitoring and evaluation, as well as conduct M&E, including report on progress, challenges and recommendations to the Royal Thai Government – World Health Organization Country Cooperation Strategy Steering Committee.

2.4 Provide consultation, advice, follow-up on progress, as well as support the implementation of each program, as appropriate.

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2.5 Appoint working groups to support implementation of the program, or to perform duties as assigned.

2.6 Perform other actions as assigned.

3. Order no.3/2561 B.E. dated 31 July 2561 B.E. titled “Appointment of the Royal Thai Government – World Health Organization Country Cooperation Strategy (RTGWHO CCS) Coordinating Subcommittee” shall be canceled.

To be effective from today onwards.
