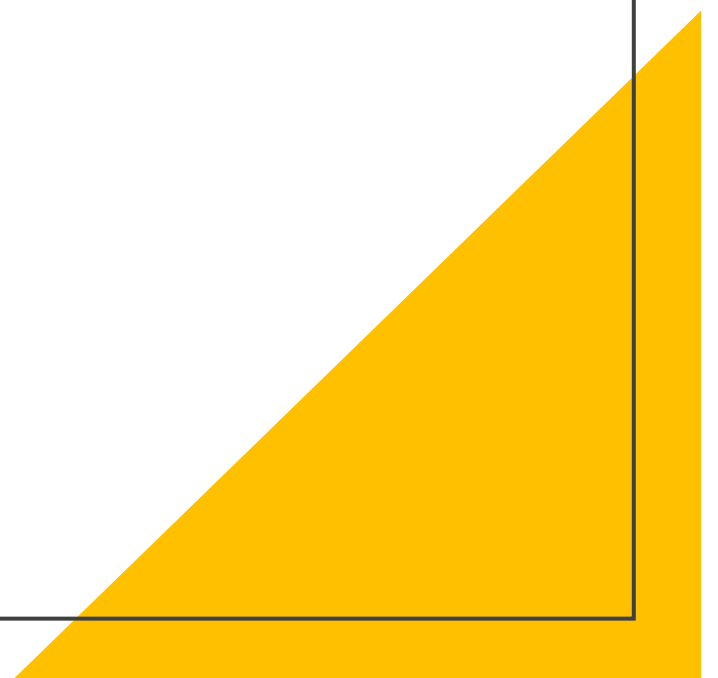

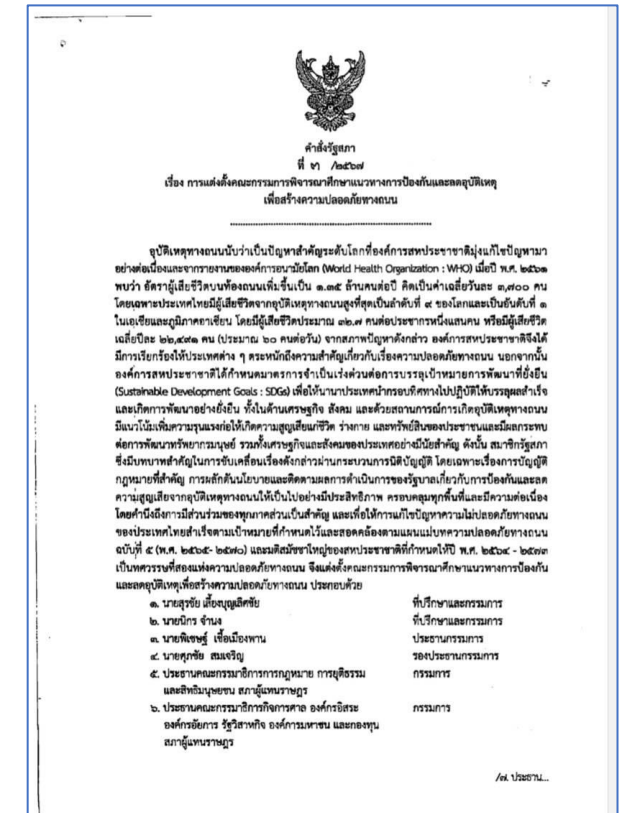

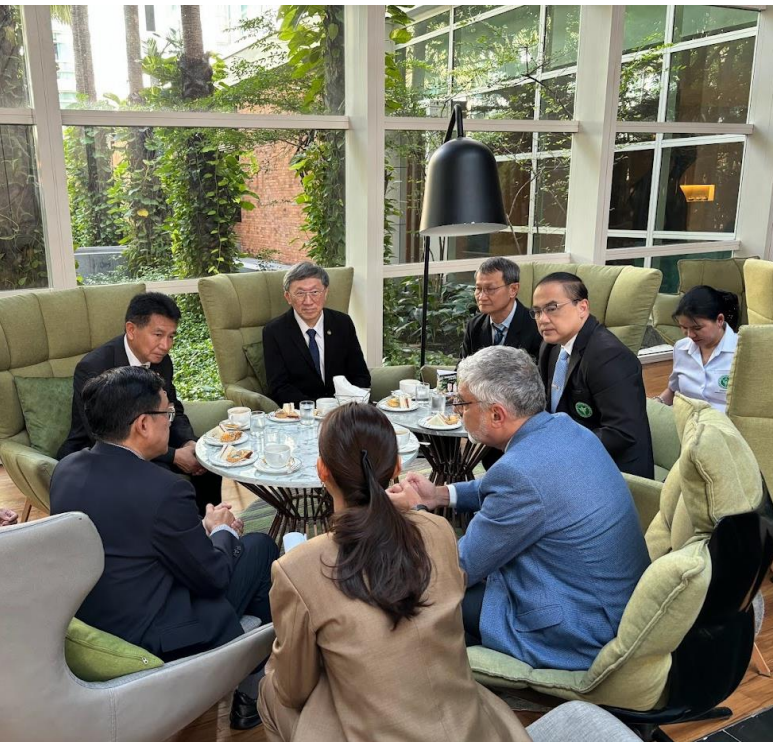

Thai Parliament Road Safety Committee Highlights

Leadership:

1. Chaired by the Deputy Speaker of the Parliament.
2. Chairpersons of the four subcommittees are leading figures in the Thai Parliament and Technical fields.

Composition:

1. Members from both the House of Representatives and the Senate.
2. Includes key road safety agencies and academics.

Authority and Functions:

1. Legal Authority:

- Provide opinions to the government.
- Oversee the work of the government and various agencies.

2. Legislative Role:

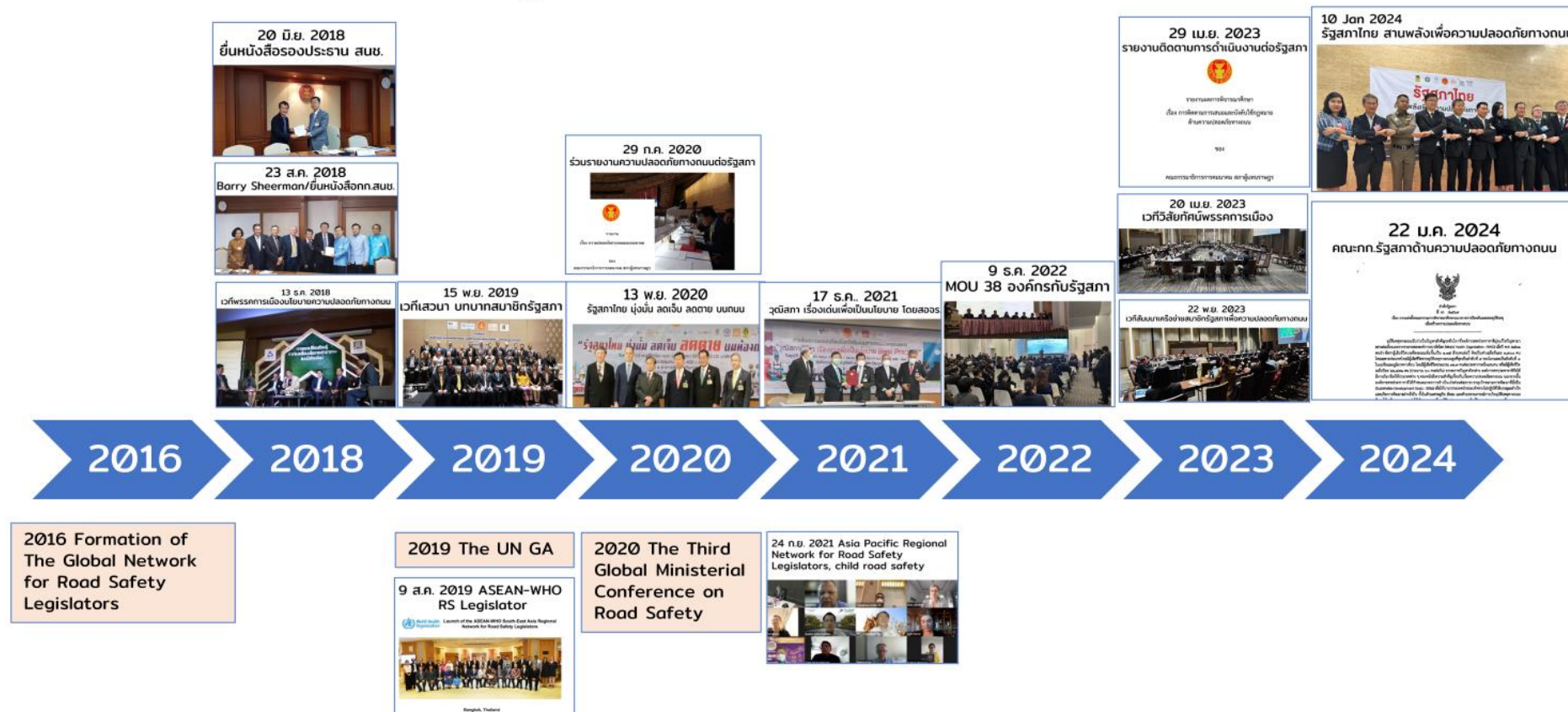
- Draft legislation.
- Consider the road safety annual budget.

3. Leadership:

- Lead society in road safety matters.

Operational Plans for 2024



Monthly Academic Network Meetings:

- Strengthen the network of academics to support parliamentary work.



Road Safety Data Preparation:

- Gather and assess data to support road safety initiatives as per the 5th Road Safety Master Plan and the Second Decade of Action on Road Safety through parliament.



Evidence-Based Motorcycle Safety Measures

- Advocate for measures to reduce motorcycle fatalities, focusing on people, vehicles, and road factors.



Enhance Parliamentary Engagement

1. Organize a public launch of the Road Safety Committee and share knowledge on parliamentary road safety mechanisms in November 2024.
2. Strengthen collaboration through PACTS UK visit.

- Coordinate and monitor government actions for large-scale travel during New Year 2025 using parliamentary mechanisms.

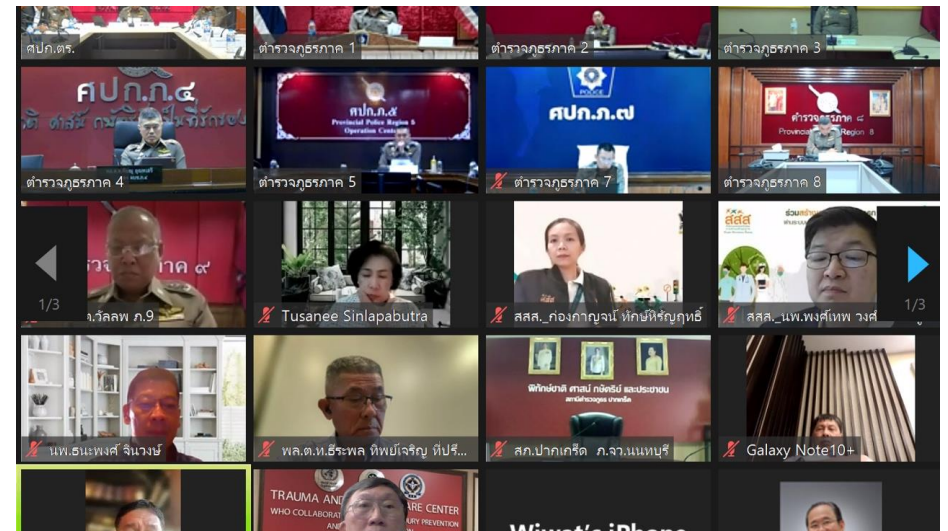

- Strong law enforcement collaboration with the Royal Thai Police, including budget allocation to all areas. Proposal to amend the Traffic Act.
