The Alliance for child protection in humanitarian action (Alliance), co-led by UNICEF and Save the Children, is a global level interagency group that focuses on standard setting and provision of technical support and guidance to actors in the field of child protection in humanitarian settings. The overall goal of the Alliance is to support the efforts of national and international actors to provide high quality and effective support and services for children to prevent and respond to violence, exploitation, abuse and neglect in humanitarian settings. In pursuit of this goal the group, undertakes work in four areas, organized as permanent working groups with the following outcomes: a) minimum standards for child protection in humanitarian action; b) assessment, measurement and evidence; c) learning and development; and d) advocacy. The Alliance also hosts multiple technical Task Forces that develop inter-agency technical material relevant to different areas of Child Protection in Emergencies.
