## Planning for Pandemics.

The small team has moved into a bigger unit PGP (Pandemic preparedness Global Platforms unit) and are building synergies with the faith work. Sarah provided a brief overview of the preparedness landscape.

- 3) Preparedness and Resilience for Emerging Threats (PRET)
- 4) IHR- updated in 2005 is an instrument of international law it includes the criteria required to declare a <u>Public Health Emergency of International Concern</u> (PHEIC).
- 5) WHO framework for <u>Strengthening the global architecture for health emergency</u> <u>prevention, preparedness and response and resilience</u> (HEPR).

- 1. Jane Ng'ang'a provided update on work of the Kenya Interfaith working council including a call to action developed in collaboration with other regional faith networks.<sup>1,2</sup>
  - a. The African Christian Health Associations Platform. ACHAP,
  - b. The Ecumenical Pharmaceutical Network EPN and
  - c. The All African Conference of Churches.
- 2. Gracia Violetta Ross provided update on work of the World Council of Churches (WCC) to establish a <a href="health.commission">health.commission</a> with four working groups: accessibility to healthcare; mental health; HIV and reproductive health; and faith in science.
- 3. Asavari Herwadkar, provided an update on participation of Hindu leaders during the COVID-19 pandemic in initiatives to support mental health; vaccine uptake and provide food to the needy.
- 4. Kathy Erb, from CCIH shared a resource, developed by a multi-faith initiative (supported by UNICEF) in India during the COVID\_19 response.<sup>3</sup>
