## Discussion overview

- WHO EYE team presented on vaccinating high-risk workers for yellow fever.
  - Protection of these workers is part of the EYE strategy 2017-2026 under the 'Prevent international spread' strategic objective <https://www.who.int/initiatives/eye-strategy>
  - There is increasing exposure to YF due to work-related activities in certain sectors. Large numbers of workers recruited internationally in certain sectors can risk spreading YF.
  - Challenges in protecting workers include lack of access to vaccination for workers in low-resource countries and lack of capacity in engaging with private sector.
  - Discussion with Network included how to collaborate with companies, unions and informal worker organizations in relevant countries and sectors and how to leverage existing ILO recommendations.

  - Discussion included intersections between postvention and suicide prevention and reporting, and mental health and work policies including differences across countries.
