Discussion overview

- Update on ILO/WHO discussion that took place on 1/10 with over 40 ILO and WHO colleagues in attendance. The discussion was organized partly in response to feedback from the Network regarding the need for further strengthened collaboration at the international agency level between health and labour for pandemic preparedness. Several areas of action emerged including opportunities for ILO specialists to attend pandemic planning simulation exercises.
- Opportunity for verbal feedback on world of work related injects for PRET national simulation exercise material.
- Update on case studies being co-developed with H-WoW Network. Purpose of the case studies is to document H-WoW work during COVID-19 and different types of collaboration between health and labour sectors during pandemics and health emergencies at national and international levels. Timeline for publication on WHO website and journal publication discussed.
- New Network members introduced themselves and some opportunities for collaboration discussed.
