

Special event of the Pacific Health Ministers on the Healthy Islands vision

Yanuca Island, Fiji | 25 October 2025







Pacific Health Ministers unite on Yanuca Island, Fiji, to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the Healthy Islands vision. This special event brings together Pacific island countries and areas to reflect on key achievements and challenges in health and is an opportunity to shape a renewed approach aligned with the 2050 Strategy for the Blue Pacific Continent Towards Healthy Islands 2050.

Grounded in regional solidarity, innovation, and cultural identity, the Healthy Islands vision aims to inspire collective action toward a healthier, more resilient Pacific. Thirty years ago, Pacific Health Ministers came together on Yanuca Island, Fiji, to adopt the Healthy Islands vision. Two decades later, in 2015, the vision was reaffirmed and expanded with a fifth and final line, completing a powerful and enduring statement of aspiration.




The Healthy Islands vision imagines a Pacific where:

For 30 years, this vision has guided the biennial Pacific Health Ministers Meetings and has become a symbol of regional unity in advancing health. It has inspired collective action, shaped national and regional health policies and strengthened Pacific solidarity.
