Implementing a healthcare-associated bloodstream infection surveillance network in India: a mixed-methods study on the best practices, challenges and opportunities, 2022

- Mixed-methods descriptive study using CDC guidelines for evaluation demonstrates a successful prospective, standardized surveillance of bloodstream infections over the last five years in India's HAI surveillance network.
- Attributes success to adopting simple case definitions, dedicated personnel and trainings, using digital records, feedback mechanisms, and sustainable funding commitment.

A multimedia tool for infection prevention and control practices in the intensive care unit: a participatory interventional before—after study

- Develops a set of nursing IPC practices (37 related to VAP and 8 to CLABSI) through a participatory approach into a multimedia tool for ventilator-associated pneumonia and central-line associated bloodstream infections.
- Using the multimedia tool improved compliance with nursing practices in a cardiac surgical ICU.

- Calls for greater integration of IPC into global surgery frameworks to achieve safer and equitable surgical care.
- Describes key guidelines, standards and initiatives to reduce surgical site infections.

- Reviews the environmental impact of IPC measures and how to sustain green IPC practices.
- Calls for standardized environmental metrics to better assess climate implications of IPC.

Highly pathogenic avian influenza: considerations for healthcare settings

- Presents a systematic approach to identify, confirm and manage avian influenza in healthcare settings.
- Calls for transparent communication with the public balancing the sharing of information while minimizing the risk of panic.

Infection control nurse: a scoping review

- Reviews roles and factors influencing infection control nurses (ICN) since 2000.
- Finds a lack of evidence on ICN programmes and calls for implementing and evaluating such programmes.

Awareness and monitoring of infection control practices among healthcare workers in three primary health centers in India

- Study finds adherence to IPC varies across the three primary health care centers (PHCs), for example, compliance to hand hygiene ranged from 38% to 66%.
- Highlights need for ongoing trainings, continuous monitoring and targeted interventions to enhance IPC among healthcare workers in PHCs.

WHO guideline on contact tracing

- Provides clear recommendations for contact tracing that are not disease specific.
- Aims to guide countries implement strategies to cost-effectively reduce transmission of diseases while upholding principles of equity and dignity.

Fifteenth Meeting of the WHO South-East Asia Regional Immunization Technical Advisory Group

- Countries update national immunization plans; India demonstrates improvements in vaccine uptake and retention due in part to successful catch-up immunization campaigns.
- Outlines regional guidance and priority setting to address vaccine preventable diseases.

Global action plan and monitoring framework on infection prevention and control (IPC), 2024-2030

- Presents strategic directions, key actions to support countries in improving national and facility-level IPC measures, along with global indicators and targets.
- Includes annexes with supplementary information.

Targeted and selective strategies in measles and rubella vaccination campaigns: interim guidance

- Guide for countries planning preventive measles and rubella vaccination campaigns aiming to target populations generally not reached in routine immunization campaigns.
- Provides expanded description of methods to determine age groups for inclusion and operational issues.

Avian influenza overview September-December 2024

- Reviews epidemiological data on avian flu in Europe, North America, Vietnam and China.
- Risk is generally low for human populations, but risks increase among people working with infected animals and in contaminated environments.
