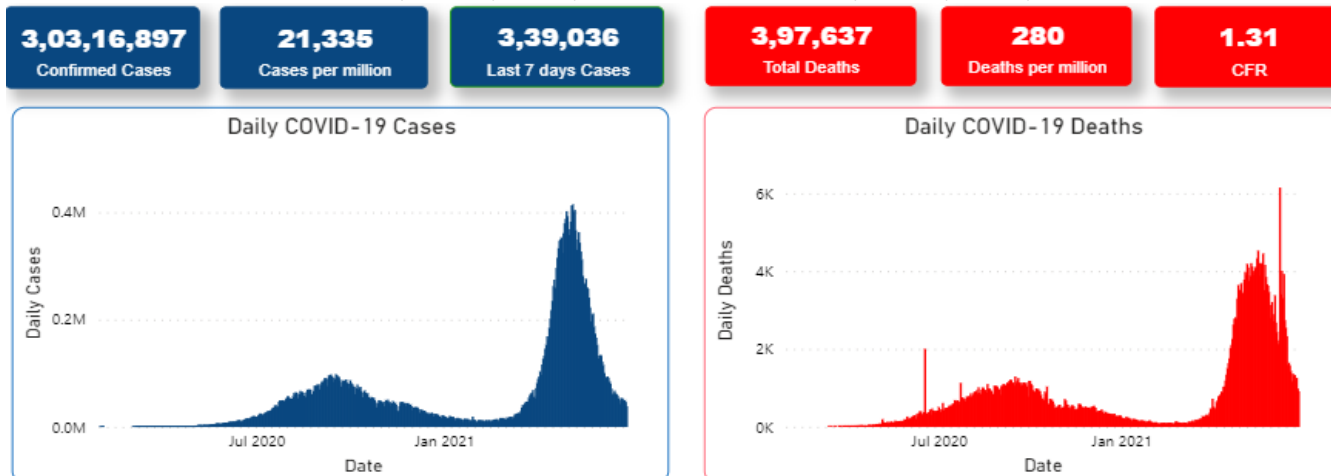

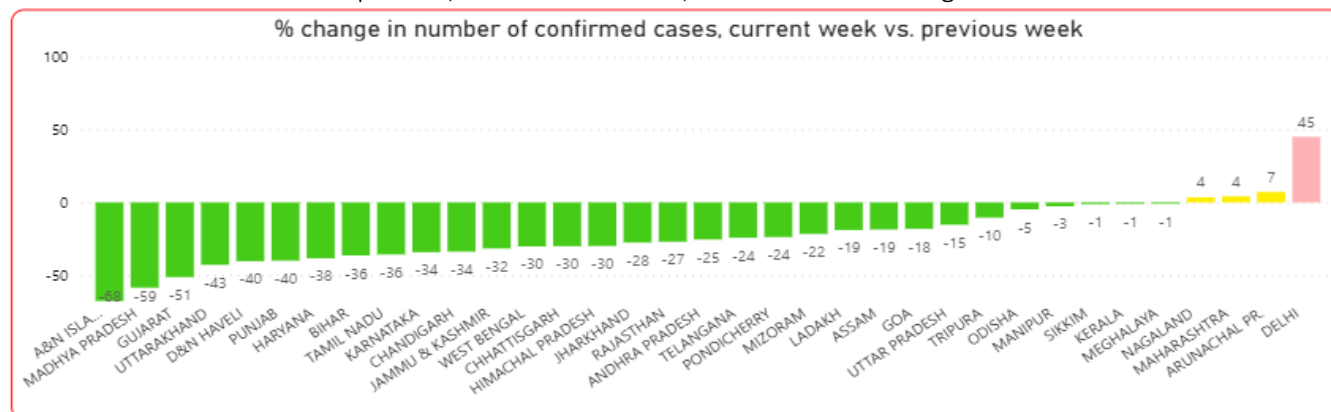
## INDIA SITUATION

- Currently, India reports 13% of new COVID cases reported globally and has recorded the second highest daily number of cases with 48,434 daily cases (7DMA) after Brazil 70,381 daily cases (7DMA).



## COVID-19: STATUS ACROSS STATES

- In the past week (23-29 June), as compared to previous week (16-22 June), all states/UTs have shown a decrease in COVID cases except Delhi, Arunachal Pradesh, Maharashtra and Nagaland.

## WHO COUNTRY UPDATE

### Coordination

- WCO is monitoring the trends using our inhouse developed indicators and thresholds and sharing the information with states/UTs.
- WHO field representatives participated in meetings on current response, third wave preparations, vaccination; chaired by Chief Ministers, Health Ministers, Chief and/or Health Secretaries, MDs – NHM, etc in **Arunachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Lakshadweep, Manipur, Nagaland Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, and Uttar Pradesh**

### COVID-19 vaccination

- WCO continues to support monitoring of vaccination sessions across the country and providing surge support for training, microplanning and monitoring
- Supporting COVID-19 vaccine sensitization training in **Tamil Nadu** in collaboration with UNICEF
- Conducted Knowledge, Attitude, and Behavior (KAB) study on COVID-19 vaccination in rural areas of **Uttar Pradesh**; the outcome of the study has been shared with State officers

### Contact Tracing, Containment and Surveillance

- Supporting house to house survey for ILI/SARI in **Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, and Uttar Pradesh**
- Supporting data analysis of the **Assam** Community Surveillance Program (Phase III); more than 12,000 cases have been identified from the surveillance program

### Information and Planning

- Assisting death audit and analysis in **Karnataka**
- Supplementing the implementation of sero-survey in **Maharashtra and Telangana**

### IPC

- Continue to support capacity building of healthcare workers regarding IPC in **Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, and Punjab**

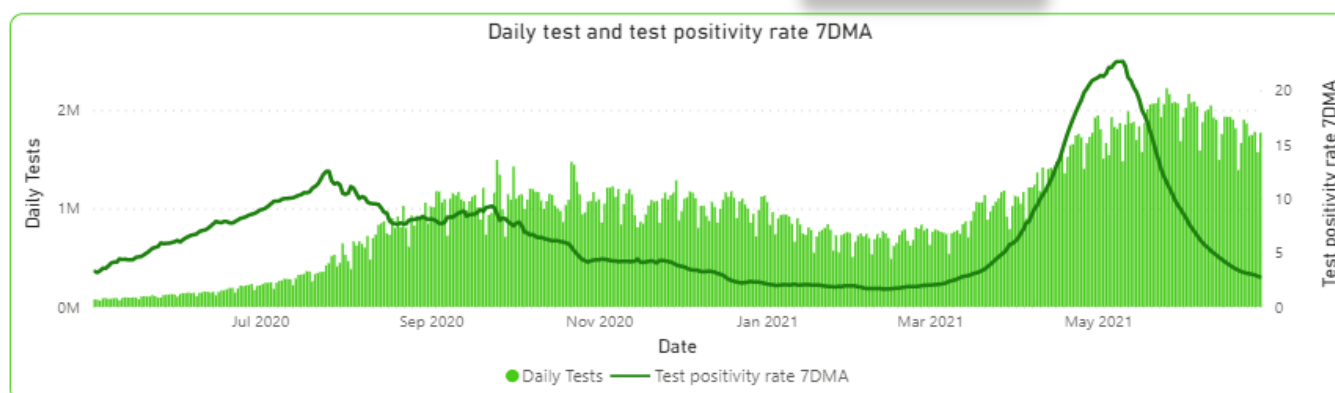
## Essential Services

- Strengthening VPD surveillance and immunization in **Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala, Lakshadweep, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and Gujarat**
- Strengthening and streamlining AEFI surveillance in **Karnataka, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and Tripura** in
- Smooth implementation of polio SNID in **Gujarat, Haryana, and Maharashtra** with
- Assisting polio sewage sampling in **Punjab**
- Support to the launch of PCV vaccine in **Odisha**

As of 29 June 2021, India has so far tested more than 398 million samples. Tests include both, RTPCR and Rapid Antigen. India's current test positivity rate (7DMA) is 2.75%.
