HIGHLIGHTS




INDIA SITUATION

• In India, in the past 24 hours, 30,941 confirmed cases have been reported; highest number of cases in a day were 4,14,188; reported on 7th May 2021. For the last several weeks, daily cases have plateaued around 25-40,000. Cases per million is 23,061.



COVID-19: STATUS ACROSS STATES

In the past week (25-31 August), as compared to previous week (18-24 August), 11 states have shown an increase in cases while 23 states have shown a decline in cases. Higher decline has been reported from Chandigarh (-99%), A&N Islands (-40%), Chhattisgarh (-36%) and Tripura (-26%).

- In **Delhi**, an action plan is being developed to respond to COVID-19 cases amongst children
- In **Uttarakhand**, six oxygen generation plants have been inaugurated and nine new oxygen plants will be established with the help of GoI in the near future
- In Uttar Pradesh, COVID-19 vaccine for kids will likely be introduced in the month of September

WHO GLOBAL UPDATE

- WHO has developed the "Social and Behavioural Insights COVID-19 Data Collection Tool for Africa". The tool can be used by WHO Country Offices, NGOs, universities or other groups interested in capturing quantitative and qualitative social and behavioural data, details here
- The heads of the International Monetary Fund, World Bank Group, WHO and World Trade Organization met with the leaders of the African Vaccine Acquisition Trust (AVAT), Africa CDC, Gavi and UNICEF to tackle o bstacles to rapidly scale-up vaccines in low- and lower middle-income countries, particularly in Africa, details here
- WHO published a guidance document for countries and implementing partners on the technical requirements

WHO COUNTRY UPDATE

Coordination

- WCO continues to provide technical support to MoHFW, NCDC, ICMR and NDMA at the national level and through task force/control rooms at the state and district level in **Andhra Pradesh**, **Karnataka**, **Kerala**, **Tamil Nadu**, **Telangana**, and **Puducherry**
- WCO officials continue to participate in meetings on current response, third wave preparations, vaccination; chaired by Chief Ministers, Health Ministers, Chief and/or Health Secretaries, MDs – NHM, etc of their respective States
- State Unit has provided technical support in causality assessment meeting in Goa

COVID-19 vaccination

- WCO is supporting monitoring of vaccination sessions across the country and continues to provide surge support for training, microplanning and monitoring
- Supporting COVID-19 vaccination Maha Abhiyaan in Madhya Pradesh

Contact Tracing, Containment and Surveillance

• Country office continues to provide technical support for COVID-19 containment activities in **Uttar Pradesh**; also provided supportive supervision to monitor contact tracing; identify containment zones and sharing regular feedback with government health officials on regular basis

- Supported training of medical officers on routine immunization in **Telangana**
- Supporting training of District Surveillance Officers regarding COVID-19 response in Uttar Pradesh


Essential Services

- Efforts to strengthen VPD surveillance and immunization are underway in Delhi, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala,
 Karnataka, Lakshadweep, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, and Telangana
- Supporting Delhi, Karnataka, and Telangana in strengthening and streamlining AEFI surveillance
- Continuing to support Polio vaccination of international travelers from Afghanistan in Delhi

As of 31 August, India has tested more than 508 million samples. Tests include both, RTPCR and Rapid Antigen. India's current test positivity rate (7DMA) is 2.5%.
