Antimicrobial Resistance Accountability Index:

application for sustainable impact

Overview

In 2024, the global community re-committed to accelerated action against antimicrobial resistance (AMR) at the high-level meeting of the United Nations General Assembly on antimicrobial resistance. But without accountability, these commitments risk becoming mere good intentions. This is why the WHO Regional Director for Europe has taken the bold step to develop the AMR Accountability Index benchmarking country performance and fostering accountability towards commitments made.

At RC73, the 53 Member States of the Region agreed that WHO/Europe should develop a monitoring, evaluation and accountability framework as part of the Roadmap on antimicrobial resistance for the WHO European Region 2023–2030 (EUR/RC73/7; endorsed in decision EUR/RC73(4)).

With this mandate, WHO/Europe now has the optimal environment to develop and pilot the AMR Accountability Index in Europe and central Asia, with the Index being the first of its kind globally. Together with the guidance provided through the Roadmap and the AMR Compass, countries are supported in prioritizing and implementing evidence-based policy interventions. The objectives of this side event are to:

- introduce the AMR Accountability Index to Member States
- consult Member States on the application of the Index to achieve sustainable impact, and
- discuss WHO/Europe's role in incubating a global accountability system.
