What is our aim?

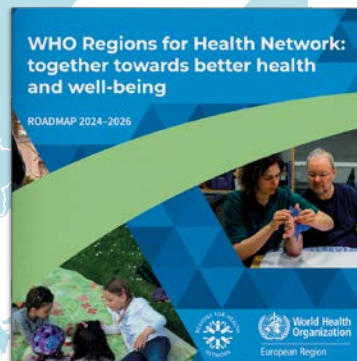
RHN, as a growing platform, brings subnational authorities across the WHO European Region together with the overall goal of:
